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### Implementation of the project

Since the very beginning of the project's life span the Italian school has actively contributed to its development. It created and continuously updated the project's specific Website. It has edited the project logo, a video, a poster and a photo album for each mobility. It has also created evaluation forms at the beginning, in the course and at the end of the project. Furthermore it has contributed to the Gentle Hymns, it has edited a multilingual brochure, a postcard and powerpoint presentations about the 8 principles of the projects, dealing with 2 out of 8 for each short exchange of pupils. All the involved pupils have produced memories about the effect their participation in the Erasmus+ project had on their life. Banners outlining the principles in all partner languages have been produced during the "Gentle Erasmus Day" organized inside the Third Transnational meeting in Italy during which Italian peer to peer approach in inclusive schools and work and study perspectives have been compared to the other methodologies applied in the special schools present in the partners' countries. Italian school has gained a lot of competences in joining workshops proposed by the hosting schools and in organizing creative ones. Thanks to this project it has implemented the principles on a day to day basis and has sparked more ideas for the partners through the identification of its own school's pillars. As soon as activities in presence were interrupted due to the corona virus spreading, ETwinning platform has been essential and Italian partner has updated it with all the outcomes. Really eTwinning at this stage can be seen as a further means of dissemination of Gentle Teaching principles, given the mental and physical state of Welsh, German and Spanish students. Accordingly during the Exchanges Italian students guided, through a peer to peer approach, their foreign mates and in the future will enhance Gentle teaching principles and pillars at school with their disabled mates. The model proposed by the Italian school had been accepted at Bonn for the TCA "Pupil mobility in Europe – making inclusion a reality" foreseen in Germany from 11th to 13th May 2020 and then cancelled due to Corona Virus.
